Brandon Mark Showalter is a journalist and podcaster with The Christian Post who has reported extensively on topics of theological interest in the Church; bioethics issues, and the developments of the "gender identity" movement and transgender ideology across the world. He was first inspired to pursue a career in writing and journalism while mopping floors and scrubbing toilets as a church custodian in April 2015. He earned a bachelor's degree in International Studies and Spanish from Bridgewater College of Virginia in 2007, a Master's degree though the Center for Human Rights at The Catholic University

of America in Washington DC, and is a fellow of the John Jay Institute for Faith, Society, & Law. He is also a graduate (class of 2015) of a three-year, non-degree program at Bethel School of Ministry in Redding, California. He has been featured in several documentaries, including Broken Hearted Films' "Dead Name" and the Tucker Carlson Originals 2-part series "Transgressive: The Cult of Confusion" on FOX Nation.

A Testimony from our Men's Groups.....

"No matter how hard I try on my own, it won't last."

I was raised in a Christian home and went to church every Sunday. There were a lot of rules and expectations required of me for being a part of the family. Unfortunately, the words "I love you" were never spoken to me. My needs were more than met, but my dad wasn't there for me emotionally. I didn't realize it then, but my view of Father God was the view I had of my own dad. He had a bunch of rules and regulations, but no real relationship.

When I was 21, I accepted Jesus Christ as my personal Lord and Savior. My life has never been the same and I am so thankful for His gift of Salvation! As time went by, I found out that getting victory over a specific sin wasn't just as easy as asking God to "take it away." I would ask forgiveness and try on my own not to repeat. That would work for a while, but I would fail time and again. This was particularly true of looking at pornography. I still remember my old-

er brother bringing home some magazines he got somewhere. A young mind is so open to be manipulated. I didn't know it, but I was giving the enemy a toehold in my life that became a foothold and ultimately a stronghold.



I have discovered, after attending Greater Hope Groups, that I didn't know what my identity was in Christ. I have learned many scriptures that tell me:

- * who I am in Christ
- that I am secure in Christ
- * that I am significant in Christ

I am not defined as what I have done or do, but Who I Am in Christ Alone! Because I know who I am in Christ, he gives me victory over the sin of pornography and other temptations in my life.

I have learned that behavioral change without heart transformation is not sustainable. In other words, no matter how hard I try on my own, it won't last. My wife tells me that I show the fruits of the spirit more than in the past. Father God helps me to be kinder and gentler to her.

I am thankful for the leaders of Greater Hope and the other men as we continue our journeys of faith.


Our Mission
